This Errata transmits a corrected copy of the PUB 373 poster, Important Food Stamp Information for Noncitizens. ACIN I-97-01 transmitted two versions of PUB 373, each with different pictures and incorrect wording. The copy of PUB 373 that is attached to this Errata contains the correct wording and replaces the two versions originally transmitted with ACIN I-97-01. Upon the release of this Errata, the Internet version of ACIN I-97-01 will be updated to contain only the corrected version of PUB 373. Please be sure that the PUB 373 poster you are using is the same as the one that is attached to this Errata.

DID YOU KNOW?

- ✓ Using food stamps will not affect your immigration status or the immigration status of your family.
- ✓ You can still apply for food stamps for your family, without applying for yourself, if you do not want to tell us your immigration status. We will not share any information about you with the Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS).
- ✓ You will be asked to give us information to figure the eligibility and benefits for the other members of your household. This information will not be shared with INS.
