SITUATION:

We have a C review for 11/00. Two Parent household. One parent is working 24 hours and the other is working 27 hours per week.

QUESTION:

Are they meeting work participation requirements?

RESPONSE:

Yes they are. Here is a listing of WTW participation hours for all programs:

**Federal and State WTW  
Participation Requirements**

**FEDERAL:**

Two-parent family:

35 hours per week if the family is not receiving federally funded child-care. Both parents may contribute toward the 35 hours requirement with no federally mandated minimum for either parent.

55 hours per week if the family receives federally funded child-care. Both parents may contribute toward the 55 hours requirement with no federally mandated minimum for either parent.

All families:

30 hours per week.

**STATE:**

Two-parent family:

35 hours per week if the family is not receiving federally funded child-care. Both parents may contribute toward the 35 hours requirement if one parent is participating at least 20 hours per week.

55 hours per week if the family receives federally funded child-care. Both parents may contribute toward the 55 hours requirement with no State mandated minimum for either parent.

All families:

32 hours per week.

**DATA REPORTING:**

Review all sample cases (two-parent or all families) to the Federal participation standards.
