### Marin County Special Care Increment Criteria

**Special Care Increments are to be used when a foster parent goes above and beyond the demands of regular parenting to meet the needs of a foster child. To qualify for a special care increment, please check the boxes where the child's needs meet the following criteria:**

#### Academic Difficulties ( \$44)

- Child has school difficulties requiring intervention or has active IEP, foster parent attends all school meetings and communicates frequently with school staff to address issues

#### Special Emotional Needs (\$38) *At least one must be present*

- Child attends therapy at least twice per month, foster parent is involved with therapy
- Child has nightmares or sleep terror that requires intervention once per week
- Child requires daily psychotropic medication management
