SUBJECT: REVISED FY 98/99 INDEPENDENT LIVING PROGRAM (ILP)
ALLOCATION

Attached is a revision to the FY 98/99 ILP allocation (see CFL 98/99-44). We are revising the FY 98/99 allocation to align the funding for the program from a federal to a state fiscal year. One-fourth of the federal funds will be re-allocated from FY 98/99 to FY 99/00 so that counties have access to four quarters of state and federal funds for the program.
