SUBJECT: DISASTER SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM INCOME ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS AND ALLOTMENTS - DISASTER GUIDANCE ATTACHMENT – EFFECTIVE **OCTOBER 1, 2014**

REFERENCE: UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, FOOD AND NUTRITION SERVICE (FNS) -- ADMINISTRATIVE NOTICE 14-53

This letter informs counties that the United States Department of Agriculture, FNS has issued the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2015 Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (D-SNAP) Income Eligibility Standards and Allotments for the period of October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015.

The computation below shows how FNS computes the Disaster Gross Income limits for a one person household:

Maximum Monthly Net Income Limit for household size of one (100% of FPL)	\$973
Maximum Standard Income Deduction	+ \$155
Maximum Shelter Expense Deduction	+ \$490
Disaster Gross Income Limit	= \$1618

8	\$4052	\$1169
Each Additional Member	+\$339	+\$146

¹ These figures include all necessary calculations. For example, for a 1-person household in the 48 States and DC, the maximum net monthly income = \$973; standard deduction = \$155; maximum shelter deduction = \$490. $\$973 + \$155 + \$490 = \1618 .
