SUBJECT: WEB-BASED TRAINING ON THE JUVENILE COURT PROCESS FOR FOSTER CARE YOUTH

The purpose of this All County Information Notice (ACIN) is to inform county welfare departments, probation departments and Title IV-E Agreement Tribes of the web-based training that was developed by the California Department of Social Services (CDSS), Funding and Eligibility Unit, in collaboration with the University of California (UC) Davis Resource Center for Family Focused practice.

The web-based training is a readily available resource created to assist the county welfare department eligibility workers with learning about the Juvenile Court process and its connection to the Title IV-E eligibility determination process. However, this web-based training does not replace the court procedures training for social workers conducted through the Regional Training Academies.

The Juvenile Court Process training is available immediately and at no cost to users. If you have previously had an account on the UC Davis' online site, login at: <http://humanservices.extensiondlc.net/>. Once you have logged in, search courses for Juvenile Court Process near the bottom of the page, click on "Juvenile Court Process." The site will now ask for an enrollment key which is "juvenilecourtprocess."

If you do not have an account on our online site, please follow the instructions below:

1. Create new account at: <http://humanservices.extensiondlc.net/login/index.php>.
2. Confirm your account via the link that will be e-mailed to you. Click on "Courses" and enroll in the online training by clicking "Juvenile Court Process." Then enter the enrollment key: juvenilecourt.

3. You can access the training by navigating to:
<http://humanservices.extensiondlc.net>. Just enter the username and password you created.

The UC Davis will host and maintain this website as well as provide technical assistance to users. Upon completing the training, users can print a certificate of completion. Web-based training is intended to be used as supplemental training material to support on-going training conducted by counties.
