SEPTEMBER 2013 QUARTERS)

This letter is to inform counties of an augmentation to the FFY 2013 CalFresh E&T Program 100 percent federal fund allocation due to the recent Food and Nutrition Service Administrative Notice 13-15, dated May 3, 2013, that allocates carry over funds. The revised allocation, shown in the Attachment, reflects a revised total of \$5,934,582 in 100 percent federal funds. With the increased amount of \$824,775 in 100 percent federal funds, counties now have the initial allocation as displayed within [ACIN NO. I-29-12](#).

Counties are reminded that the 100 percent federal funds exclude the holdbacks for state operations and workers compensation. Counties will also continue to claim expenditures for CalFresh E&T activities using the County Expense Claim (CEC) process, as stated in [CFL NO. 12/13-23](#).
