This letter informs counties of a funding redistribution of \$1,020,000 in federal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families funds and General Fund in the FY 2013-14 allocation for the CalWORKs FS Program. These funds are being redistributed as requested by the County Welfare Directors Association (CWDA). The CWDA determined the redistribution of funding amongst counties to ensure the maximum expenditure rate of available funds.
