This letter notifies counties of the SA allocation for the CalWORKs program for FY 2014-15. A total of \$1.93 billion in federal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Funds and General Fund (GF) was made available by the approved Budget Act of 2014.

Attachment I displays a summary of the CalWORKs SA funds for the following program components: Eligibility Administration, Welfare-to-Work (WTW) Employment Services, Cal-Learn and Stage One Child Care.

CalWORKs Eligibility Administration, WTW Employment Services and Stage One Child Care

Attachment II displays each county's FY 2014-15 allocation for the CalWORKs Eligibility Administration, WTW Employment Services and Stage One Child Care. The funding for these components reflects the administration and services costs of the CalWORKs program, as well as direct services delivery costs.

In accordance with the County Welfare Directors Association (CWDA) recommendation, a total of \$1.89 billion for CalWORKs Eligibility Administration, WTW Employment

Services and Stage One Child Care components is distributed as follows: since funding for the FY 2014-15 Eligibility Administration, WTW Employment Services and Stage One Child Care components are less than the FY 2013-14 components, the difference is distributed based on a percent to total of each county's FY 2013-14 total allocated funds for CalWORKs Eligibility Administration, WTW Employment Services and Stage One Child Care.

Please note, the flexibility to redirect funds between the CalWORKs SA and Mental Health and Substance Abuse sunsetted June 30, 2014. Starting July 1, 2014, the FY 2014-15 Mental Health and Substance Abuse allocation resumes as a separate allocation per CFL NO.14/15-02 dated July 25, 2014.

Cal-Learn

Attachment I displays the FY 2014-15 Cal-Learn allocation in the amount of \$34.3 million for the administration and service costs of providing intensive case management, supportive services and fiscal incentives/disincentives to eligible teen recipients who are pregnant or parenting and participating in the Cal-Learn Program.

In consultation with CWDA, the Cal-Learn funds were distributed on a percent to total of each county's average monthly caseload for Calendar Year 2013, as reported on the Cal-Learn Program Teen Parent Monthly Status Report (STAT 45). An adjustment was made to ensure a minimum allocation of \$1,000 for each county.

Drug Felon Eligibility

Due to statutory changes made by Assembly Bill 1468, Chapter 26, Statutes of 2014, adults with drug felony convictions will be eligible for CalWORKs assistance as of April 1, 2015. Additionally, these adults will also be eligible to receive CalWORKs employment services and Stage One Child Care to the extent the cases would be otherwise eligible. Drug Felon Eligibility funding of \$6.7 million is provided as part of the CalWORKs SA for administrative costs.

Regional Market Rate (RMR) Increase

Commencing January 1, 2015, the RMR ceilings will be established at either the greater of the 85th percentile of the 2009 RMR survey with a reduction factor or the 85th percentile of the 2005 RMR survey pursuant to Education Code section 8357. The costs for the RMR increase are reflected in the CalWORKs Stage One Child Care funds.

Linkages Contract

The CWDA Board has decided to continue funding for the Linkages contract out of the SA. Stanislaus County has volunteered to manage that contract on behalf of all the Linkages counties. A proportional amount from all counties based on a percent-to-total was redirected to Stanislaus County.

Program Codes (PCs)

Attachment III provides a complete listing of PCs available for claiming to the CalWORKs SA. Expenditures charged against these PCs are tracked against the CalWORKs SA ledger on the quarterly County Expense Claim.
