SUBJECT: SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION (SSA) COST-OF-LIVING
ADJUSTMENT (COLA) –EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2011

Social Security recipients will receive a 3.6 percent cost-of-living increase in their Social Security benefits effective December 1, 2011, which is payable January 2012. The new Social Security benefit amount can be determined by multiplying the former benefit amount by 1.036. This increase will affect California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) cash aid and CalFresh allotment amounts. When cash aid or CalFresh allotment amounts are adjusted due to the Social Security COLA benefit increase, the requirements for a timely and adequate Notice of Action shall apply pursuant to CalFresh Manual of Policies and Procedures (MPP) Section 63-504.26 and CalWORKs MPP Sections 22-071 and 22-072.

NEW APPLICANTS

For new applicants in both the CalWORKs and CalFresh programs, the actual amount of the Social Security benefit, including the increase, shall be used for eligibility and budgeting purposes beginning with the month of January 2012.

TREATMENT OF THE SSA COLA IN THE CURRENT QUARTER (OCTOBER, NOVEMBER, DECEMBER)

For CalWORKs and CalFresh households currently in the October, November, and December quarter, the County Welfare Department (CWD) will reasonably anticipate the increase in the Social Security income in accordance with CalWORKs MPP Section 44-315.3 and CalFresh MPP Section 63-509(a) (2). The amount of the SSA COLA will be considered known to the county, per MPP Section 63-509(h) (3) and 44-316.331 (QR) (r), upon receipt of this ACIN and will be reasonably anticipated to be received by recipients of Social Security benefits beginning in January 2012 and thereafter. Therefore, starting with the Quarterly Reporting (QR) Data Month of November 2011, the SSA COLA will be reasonably anticipated to be received in the QR Payment Quarter of January/February/March 2012.

COUNTY INITIATED MID-QUARTER CHANGES FOR ALL OTHER CalWORKs AND CalFresh HOUSEHOLDS

MPP 44-316.331 (QR) (r) and 63-509(h) provide that counties shall take mid-quarter actions based on SSA COLAs. Since the SSA COLA is effective December 2011 and payable in January, counties are to take a mid-quarter county-initiated action to decrease benefits effective January 1, 2012 for all cases in which Social Security benefits are being used to determine CalFresh allotments or CalWORKS cash grant amounts.

CalFresh CHANGE REPORTING HOUSEHOLDS

Pursuant to MPP Section 63-504.46, CWDs are required to automatically adjust CalFresh benefits to reflect the SSA COLA no later than the second allotment issued after the month in which the change becomes effective for non-quarterly reporting households.

PAYMENT VERIFICATION SYSTEM (PVS) COLA NOTIFICATION

The California Department of Social Services (CDSS) will not be providing additional notification of the SSA COLA through the PVS. However, upon request, a cost-of-living printout or magnetic tape will be provided to the counties. The COLA printouts will be subject to the 45-day timeliness requirements of the Income Eligibility Verification System (IEVS).
