SUBJECT: JOB ACCESS AND REVERSE COMMUTING IN CALIFORNIA
THE PUBLIC AGENCY – TRANSIT CONNECTION

The purpose of this letter is to invite all County Welfare Directors, Welfare to Work Coordinators, Transportation Coordinators, and Indian Health Clinics to attend a two-day Job Access and Reverse Commute Conference. The conference is scheduled for October 9 and 10, 2002, at the Oakland Marriott City Center. Important issues regarding job access and reverse commuting in California will be explored by state and local officials, social service workers, transportation coordinators, employers, researchers, and others.

The goal of the conference is to engage conference participants in developing transportation solutions, form a statewide advisory committee to guide policy, and create cost-effective welfare-to-work transportation services throughout the State. Due to a limit of 150 attendees, it is important that interested parties register immediately. The enclosed brochure will provide registration information as well as information on the various conference workshops.
