**SUBJECT: 2008 COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENTS THAT AFFECT THE CASH ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR IMMIGRANTS (CAPI)****REFERENCE: ACIN I-75-07 and ACL 99-13**

This All-County Information Notice (ACIN) provides the new Cash Assistance Program for Immigrants (CAPI) Payment Standards, effective October 1, 2008. The attached CAPI Payment Standards chart details the payment standards that will be effective on October 1, 2008.

As required by section 18941 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, the CAPI payment standards are based on the Supplemental Security Income/State Supplementary Program (SSI/SSP) payment standards, minus \$10 for an individual and \$20 for a couple. Under the provisions of Assembly Bill (AB) X3 6 (Chapter 4, Statutes of 2008), the State SSP Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) which was previously scheduled for implementation on June 1, 2008, will instead become effective on October 1, 2008. The CAPI Payment Standards that will become effective on October 1, 2008 are reflected on the attached charts.

There are no changes to the 2008 rates for the Presumed Maximum Value of In-Kind Support and Maintenance, Allowance for Ineligible Children in Deeming Situations, Sponsor's Allocation in Deeming Situations, or COLA Coordination When One Spouse Receives SSI/SSP as a result of this change.
