SUBJECT: 2008 COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENTS THAT AFFECT THE CASH ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR IMMIGRANTS (CAPI)

REFERENCE: ACIN I-26-08 and ACL 99-13

This All-County Information Notice (ACIN) provides the Cash Assistance Program for Immigrants (CAPI) Payment Standards effective January 1, 2008. The attached CAPI Payment Standards chart details the payment standards that will remain in effect throughout 2008.

As required by section 18941 of the Welfare and Institutions Code (WIC), the CAPI payment standards are based on the SSI/SSP payment standards, minus \$10.00 for an individual and \$20.00 for a couple. Under the provisions of Assembly Bill (AB) 1279 (Chapter 759, Statutes of 2008), the State SSP Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) which was previously scheduled for implementation on October 1, 2008 was repealed and will not become effective in 2008. The CAPI Payment Standards that will remain in effect for 2008 are reflected on the attached chart.

As a result of the SSP COLA suspension, there are no changes to the 2008 rates for the Presumed Maximum Value of In-Kind Support and Maintenance, Allowance for Ineligible Children in Deeming Situations, Sponsor's Allocation in Deeming Situations or COLA Coordination When One Spouse Receives SSI/SSP.
