TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: RESULTS OF ANNUAL SURVEY OF FAMILY PLANNING PROCEDURES
OF COUNTY WELFARE DEPARTMENTS FOR JANUARY 1979

REFERENCE: ALL-COUNTY INFORMATION NOTICE I-11-79

Section 10053.3 of the Welfare and Institutions Code requires county welfare departments (CWD) to periodically report on the procedures used to inform persons of their eligibility for and the availability of family planning services.

In the past, each county welfare department has completed an annual questionnaire describing its family planning procedures for the Department of Social Services. The information on these questionnaires was then compiled and a report was prepared and distributed to CWD and others. The last such report was for January 1978 ("Family Planning Procedures Report, January 1978", Report Register Number 0586-901).

Since, over the years, few changes have been reported by the CWD's in their family planning programs, we made an effort to ease the workload for this reporting requirement by modifying the reporting procedure this year.

Each CWD was asked: 1) to indicate whether significant changes had occurred in its family planning program since January 1978 and, if so, to describe them; and, 2) to provide the name of its current coordinator of family planning services.

The results of this survey indicated that of the 58 county welfare departments, in eight counties it was the opinion of their family planning coordinator that there had been significant changes in their family planning services program since January 1978. The types of changes for these counties are listed on the attached pages. For the remaining 50 county welfare departments, the programs remained unchanged since January 1978, and thus the January 1978 report mentioned above continues to describe the programs in

these counties. Also attached is the name and address of each county's family planning coordinator as of January 1979.

The attached material, together with the January 1978 report, constitutes the Family Planning Procedures Report, January 1979.

CHANGES IN FAMILY PLANNING PROCEDURES OF COUNTY WELFARE DEPARTMENTS
SINCE JANUARY 1978

Eight counties reported changes in their family planning program procedures since January 1978. Here is a brief description of these changes.

Fresno County:

"The Family Planning Worker is now actively involved in the community in creating and developing a comprehensive Family Planning program, concentrating on prevention and resources, with major emphasis on the sexually active minor.

As part of this comprehensive concept the Family Planner is attached to the Adoption Unit providing counseling for adoption as a viable family planning alternative."

Inyo County:

"Coordination meetings are being held monthly with Health Department to evaluate current programs and improve (especially) high school contacts."

Madera County:

"Family Planning Services are no longer in a specialized caseload due to the reallocation in Title XX funding which resulted in the demotion of services personnel. We are unable to have specialized caseloads. The remaining staff assesses the Mandated services, including Family Planning."

Mendocino County:

"We are no longer providing family planning services as a Title XX service. We continue to direct clients to the Family Planning Clinic as an I & R service. Deletion of this service from the CASPP was approved by State."

DSS Note: Family planning is a mandated service and must be provided in all Title XX geographical areas. Department of Social Services staff is working with Mendocino County to rectify any misunderstandings and the county will be required to make corrections in their final CASPP.

Merced County:

"The Eligibility Worker now initiates family planning information at an appropriate time in the course of client contact. The Eligibility Worker also offers supportive services to help the individual make optimum use of the family planning services by referral to Social Worker."

DSS Note: Department of Social Services staff is working with Merced County to insure that Eligibility Workers are limiting their involvement in family planning services to referral to a Social Worker. The Social Worker is responsible for provision of family planning services, including supportive services.

Monterey County:

"DSS no longer provides problem pregnancy and sterilization counseling for the County Health Department; loss of one Social Worker; direct Social Work services provided by one MSW and 1/2 time vocational Assistant."

San Luis Obispo County:

"Family Planning information sheet was revised. This sheet is given to all Medi-Cal and AFDC applicants and recipients at redetermination of eligibility."

Stanislaus County:

"The practice of direct contact with each new AFDC mother is now only provided upon request. The time gained by this change is used to provide family planning counseling "on site" at the local family planning clinic."

Although Mariposa County indicated that there had been no significant changes in their family planning program since January 1978, they submitted the following comment:

Mariposa County:

"Our Department only makes referrals to the Health Department (in the same building) and it is they who provide the FP Services. We do provide transportation on occasion when necessary to obtain abortions. We have deleted FP Services in our 79-80 CASP."

DSS Note: Family planning is a mandated service and must be provided in all Title XX geographical areas. Department of Social Services staff is working with Mariposa County to rectify any misunderstandings and the county will be required to make corrections in their final CASPP.
