
This is to advise you that sometime during February, 1981, the Employment Development Department (EDD) will begin providing UI Claimant Abstracts on 8½" x 11" paper instead of the 11" x 14" printouts counties have been receiving. The format and the content of the abstract will remain unchanged, and the new laser printing process will provide clear and legible characters.

Advantages of the smaller abstract include the following:

1. Paper cost savings for EDD.
2. Elimination of the cost of photo-reducing 11" x 14" printouts to 8½" x 11" size. This is now required before microfiche processing of Claimant Abstracts in some county welfare departments.
3. Convenience of filing abstracts in case folders.
