TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: CHANGES IN THE REQUIREMENTS FOR REPORTING STATISTICS ON AFDC FG/U  
CHILDREN AND CHILDREN IN FOSTER CARE NEEDED TO IMPLEMENT THE  
ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION ACT FOR OCTOBER 1981.

REFERENCE:

The Department of Social Services has just recently received from the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) the reporting instructions for the collection of 1981 data for allocations under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act.


Because of the late receipt of the HHS package and changes in the reporting requirements, the Department is providing a quick overview of these changes to enable counties to prepare for data compilation. A final report package, including revised CA 802 and CA 803 forms, will be issued as soon as possible.

In the interim, counties should begin working on compiling the data for the report based on the HHS changes described below:

1. Count both in-state and out-of-state children by county paying for the support of the child. This may be different from the county of residence or the county in which the child attends school.
2. Report only those AFDC children aged 5-17 in families with an October, 1981 grant in excess of \$704. (Each included case must have at least one federally eligible child with a birth-date falling on November 1, 1963, through October 31, 1976, inclusive.)
