SUBJECT: REGIONAL TRAINING WORKSHOPS - AFDC FOSTER CARE REGULATIONS

REFERENCE:

The purpose of this ACIN is to advise you of regional training workshops scheduled for the month of January 1982 on the AFDC-Foster Care program as set forth in the regulations implementing Assembly Bill 2749.

Assembly Bill 2749 (Chapter 1166, Statutes of 1980) provides specific statutory authority for the AFDC-Foster Care program, specifies eligibility requirements for payment of AFDC-FC and increases procedural protections for children receiving such payments. Regulations to implement AB 2749 will be effective on January 1, 1982.

Since county implementation of these regulations will involve county welfare department (CWD) income maintenance staff as well as placement staff of CWDs, probation departments and adoption agencies, we encourage staff from each agency to participate in this training. The workshops will be working sessions with limited space available. We request that each CWD send no more than two staff each from income maintenance and services and that probation departments and adoption agencies also limit attendance to no more than two staff from each department/agency.

The workshops will begin at 10:00 a.m. and end at 3:00 p.m. and are scheduled as follows:


