ALL-COUNTY INFORMATION NOTICE I- 142-82

TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: NEW IHSS REGULATIONS

REFERENCE:

This is to explain and clarify the types of changes that have been made in the numbering of the In-Home Supportive Services regulations as a result of the SB 14 emergency regulations package that was filed on October 1, 1982.

You will receive a separate All County Letter outlining the steps necessary to implement the program changes.

1. All of the IHSS regulations were moved from the 30-450 series to the 30-750 series. This was necessary to allow more room for the new Child Welfare Services regulations.
2. All sections and subsections remain in the same order and sequence as previously arranged.
3. The major sections retain the same last two digits. For example, NEEDS ASSESSMENT PROCESS, which was formerly 30-463 is now 30-763.
4. Some subsections have been renumbered in order to conform to a standardized regulations numbering system. However, the sequence remains the same. For example, the former 30-457.1 is now 30-757.11, and the former 30-457.2 is now 30-757.12, followed by13, .14 and so on.
5. Cross references have been changed to conform to the new numbering system. Some cross references which were erroneous in the old regulations have been corrected.
6. Certain subsections have been renumbered where they were out of order, due to repeal of preceding subsections. For example, the former 463.245 is now 763.244 and the following subsections adjusted accordingly.

7. Renumbered Sections 30-755.21, 30-759.5, 30-761.13, 30-761.212, 30-761.275 and 30-769.23 have been amended to implement the change to a 12 month reassessment period, as provided for in SB 14.

There remain some errors in the renumbering. An editorial amendment is being requested to correct these.

In the meantime, the regulations as filed on October 1, 1982 are now legally in effect. You should use these numbers when citing or referencing any IHSS regulation, such as on a Notice of Action. When the editorial changes are filed, an errata notice will be sent out, and subsequent references should cite the corrected numbers.
