
ALL-COUNTY INFORMATION NOTICE NO. 1-155-82

TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: LIMIT ON DISTRIBUTION OF ACL'S AND ACIN'S

In view of severe budget constraints, it has become necessary to limit the number of copies of All-County Letters and All-County Information Notices routinely sent to counties. An initial decision considered by the Department would have limited distribution to a standard number of five copies per county welfare department.

As a result of discussions with officers of the County Welfare Directors Association, the Department agreed to delay a final decision pending the outcome of a quick survey to be conducted by the Association. The survey involved those counties currently receiving more than five copies of these publications. Based upon the results of that survey, the Department has decided to provide counties with the number of copies requested in the survey up to a maximum number of ten. Counties not involved in the survey will continue to receive the same number of copies received in the past. This will provide the vast majority of counties with the actual number of copies requested. We regret any inconvenience caused by the limit of ten copies; but in view of the fiscal circumstances confronting us at this time, I am confident you will view the decision as a reasonable one.
