SUBJECT: POSSIBLE POSTAL STRIKE

We have been advised by FNS that the Postal Service employees' contract will expire on July 21, 1984. There is a possibility that the postal employees may go on strike. It is our understanding that negotiations should begin on July 20, 1984 and the decision be made at their August 20 convention.

FNS is not anticipating a strike but if there is one, the duration is not expected to be long and adjustments may be necessary in food coupon ordering and issuance. The Postal Service is preparing a contingency plan and anticipates the mail will go through however slowly.

This ACIN is intended to alert you to the possibility of the strike so that you may be prepared with a contingency plan should it occur. If you have any questions, please contact your Food Stamp Corrective Action Bureau consultant.
