SUBJECT: REIMBURSEMENTS FOR TUITION AND RELATED EDUCATIONAL
COSTS FOR CHILDREN PLACED IN OTHER STATES

REFERENCE:

All-County Information Notice I-10-84 dated January 12, 1984 advised that the State of Illinois requires the sending agency which places any non-resident school-age child into that state to negotiate a contract with the local school district in that state ensuring reimbursement for tuition and related educational costs.

It has been learned since that other states also have this requirement, notably Indiana, Missouri and Ohio. When planning placements of school-age children in other states inquiry should be made of the local agency in the receiving state whether such a requirement exists and, if so, the procedures for negotiating payment.

Note that approval of the placement by the Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children Administrator in the receiving state does not waive the requirement that the educational costs be reimbursed to the local school district in that receiving state.
