TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: FNS CIVIL RIGHTS POSTER

We have been advised by the United States Department of Agriculture, Food and Nutrition Service (USDA/FNS) that the new "...And Justice For All" Civil Rights poster is available for distribution. A reduced copy of the new poster is attached. The actual size is 11 x 17 inches and is magenta, blue and white.

Please note that "religion" is included on the poster as a protected class. The Food and Nutrition Service states that although there is no existing legislation except for the Food Stamp Act that covers "religion" as a protected class in FNS programs, USDA has other agencies that also cover "religion". Thus "religion" is retained as part of the USDA Civil Rights poster text and complaints alleging religious discrimination will be processed according to present procedures. Also, please note that while the poster does not refer to political belief as a prohibited discrimination, this category is covered by 7 CFR 271.6 of the Food Stamp Program Regulations. Complaints against the Food Stamp Program, based on political belief, will also be processed according to present procedures.


In the past, county welfare departments were instructed to order FNS posters directly from the FNS regional office in San Francisco. The State Department of Social Services (SDSS) has been provided a quantity of FNS posters and, for the present, will distribute them to the counties.
