SUBJECT: IN-HOME SUPPORTIVE SERVICE (IHSS) CASE  
MANAGEMENT INFORMATION PAYROLLING SYSTEM  
(CMIPS): ADDITIONAL PRIMARY LANGUAGE CODES

The IHSS CMIPS is adding two primary language codes to field F4 on the In-Home Supportive Services Assessment Form (SOC 293). The first one is "9" which identifies recipients whose primary language is Spanish but who need English Notices of Action (NOAs). An example of such recipients is a person under protective supervision whose provider or alternative resource person can only read English. This special coding is being implemented at county request to accommodate recipients who fall into this special category. It is imperative that care be taken to avoid the erroneous use of this code. The Civil Rights Bureau will be monitoring this coding for compliance with the Civil Rights regulations.

The other additional primary language code is "0". This will identify the recipients as having American Sign Language (AMISLAN) as a primary language. This code will generate NOAs in English.

These two codes will be in place effective as of the date of this ACIN.
