TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: INCOME AND ELIGIBILITY VERIFICATION SYSTEM (IEVS)

REFERENCE:

The purpose of this letter is to provide counties with updated information on the status of IEVS implementation. The State Department of Social Services (SDSS) and the State Department of Health Services (SDHS) have worked jointly towards statewide implementation of the federally mandated matching system for the Aid to Families With Dependent Children (AFDC), Food Stamp, and Medi-Cal programs.

In early 1987, we developed a 12-month phase-in schedule for the IEVS applicant system effective October 1, 1987. (Each county successfully implemented the recipient portion of IEVS for the AFDC and Food Stamp programs in July 1987.)

We are extremely pleased to inform you that because of the county cooperation, and assistance, we successfully met our deadline. As of October 1, 1988, all 58 counties have implemented IEVS.

We would like to take this opportunity to extend our thanks to each County, especially to the IEVS project staff. Your input, cooperation and continued support is greatly appreciated.

The hard work, professionalism, and integrity of each County Welfare Department has made California the leader in IEVS implementation nationwide.
