Attached is a copy of the State plan for supportive services under the Family Support Act (FSA) of 1988 (P.L. 100-485). This plan has been drafted in accordance with the instructions from U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and is a companion to the State plan for implementation of the Job Opportunities and Basic Skills (JOBS) Training Program referenced in ACIN No. I-12-89. The plan describes existing Greater Avenues for Independence (GAIN) Program supportive services policies and Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) policies for persons who are not participating in GAIN and who are working.
