TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: Forms Changes Under the Family Support Act (FSA) of 1988

The purpose of this letter is to advise counties of forms which must be changed due specifically to the income disregard provisions of the Family Support Act (FSA) of 1988. These provisions are anticipated to be implemented October 1, 1989 and will change the way earned income computations are figured.

The following forms are in the process of revision due to the income disregard changes:

- AFDC Budget Worksheet, CA 30
- Change/Approval, NA 200
- Approval, AFDC State-U, NA 201
- Approval, AFDC EA (then State-U), NA 202
- Deny, Discontinue, Suspend—Financial Eligibility and Lump Sum, NA 210

In addition, the NA 274, Continuation Page—Overpayment Computation is being revised to include the 185% computation. However, the income computation will remain as it is currently for the purpose of showing overpayment computations prior to October 1, 1989. A new form, which will be similar in format to the NA 274, is in the process of development and will be used to show overpayment computations effective October 1, 1989 and afterward.


Note that the income disregard computation found in Message No. M44-207 Q, Darces v. Woods, will not be changed at this time. If counties need to use this message, they should make the appropriate change.

Counties are advised to be conservative when ordering stock on the above forms. Counties which print or reproduce stock locally should also limit stock based on the FSA anticipated implementation date of October 1, 1989.

It will be acceptable to use current stock on hand providing the old computation is deleted or crossed out. A continuation sheet must be attached showing the new computation. However, this would be acceptable only as an interim procedure until counties could deplete stock on hand and print revisions incorporating the new computation sequence under FSA. A form will be developed for counties to use on a temporary basis for this purpose. It will not be stocked in the DSS Warehouse.

Reference copies of the newly revised forms will be issued as soon as they are ready. We anticipate that this will be in August 1989. The forms will be translated into Spanish, Cambodian, Chinese, Hmong, Lao and Vietnamese.
