SUBJECT: INTERSTATE COMPACT ON THE PLACEMENT OF CHILDREN (ICPC)

This All County Information Notice (ACIN) contains information regarding the delegation of responsibilities held by the Interstate Placement Bureau (IPB) to local county welfare and probation departments, licensed public and private adoption agencies, and State Adoptions District Offices.

On or about September 13, 1991, all responsibilities held by the IPB will be delegated to the local county welfare and probation departments, licensed public or private adoption agencies and State Adoptions District Offices. The effective date is dependent upon the filing of emergency regulations which is expected to be September 3, 1991. The emergency regulations are effective ten days after filing. Given normal mail time we recommend that no ICPC correspondence should be forwarded to IPB after August 30, 1991.

CALIFORNIA AS A SENDING STATE

Local California agencies, when designated as sending agencies, will prepare and forward Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children (ICPC) placement request packages directly to the Compact Administrator in the receiving state. With the elimination of the IPB, California local sending agencies will only need to forward two (2) complete packets of information along with four (4) copies of the ICPC 100A to the appropriate public authority in the receiving state.

A problematic issue in the ICPC referral process for county departments of social services is an acceptable financial and medical plan which includes Federal Title IV-E information.

Attached to this ACIN are copies of acceptable financial and medical forms developed by two counties. Upon completion and verification of Federal Title IV-E eligibility, when applicable, either of these two (2) forms is appropriate for an interstate referral package.

In independent adoption matters, although the California birth parent(s) continues to be the sending agency, the ICPC independent adoption referral package will be sent from that parent(s) to the appropriate delegated county agency or the State Adoptions District Office for review and action as the sending state compact administrator.

CALIFORNIA AS A RECEIVING STATE

When California is the receiving state in an ICPC case, the sending state Compact administrator will request information from the California local receiving agency. For placements other than adoptive placements, the local California receiving agency will conduct a pre-placement assessment, make a recommendation, and a disposition as to whether the placement may be made or not. The California receiving agency will then forward the completed ICPC 100A and two (2) copies of the home study to the sending state Compact Administrator.

When a California licensed public or private adoption agency is the receiving agency, the receiving agency will make the recommendation and disposition based upon its homestudy of the prospective adoptive parents and forward the completed ICPC 100A with two (2) copies of the homestudy to the sending state's Compact Administrator.

When California is the receiving state in an independent adoption, the delegated county agency or the State Adoptions District Office will review the referral materials, conduct the pre-placement assessment, make the recommendation, or review the pre-placement homestudy, and make the disposition on the completed ICPC 100A. The delegated county agency or the State Adoptions District Office will then forward the completed ICPC 100A along with two (2) copies of the homestudy to the sending state's appropriate public authority.

When California is a receiving state, the ICPC casefile is either closed or kept open following disposition. Upon

notification that the minor has been placed, via the ICPC 100B from the sending agency, the receiving agency is to provide post-placement supervision reports at the frequency noted on the ICPC 100A which authorizes placement.

Common problems which are encountered during the post-placement period are:

- * disruption of the placement with the need to replace the minor in California or return to the home state;
- * lack of financial and/or medical care coverage;
- * disagreement between the sending and receiving state regarding practice or procedures.

When ICPC concerns are noted, they should be addressed between the local California agency and the appropriate public authority in the other state. Every effort should be made to resolve issues at the local level. If a major and critical issue remains unresolved, you may write to the Department for assistance. Due to severe budgetary constraints, there may be delays in addressing your specific concern.

Emergency regulations are being drafted and will be distributed as an ACIN.

ICPC TRAINING PACKETS

ICPC training packets were distributed to all county welfare department ICPC liaison contacts during June, 1991. Packets were distributed following IPB's training of county social workers, probation officers, and public and private adoption agency personnel. The IPB training packets focus on a California local agency as the sending agency. If you need an additional training packet, please advise us.

STATE ICPC ADMINISTRATORS

Attached is a list of names, addresses, and telephone numbers of the ICPC Compact Administrators of other states. Please refer to this list as the need arises.

DISPOSITION OF IPB FILES

Current IPB casefiles, which are duplicates of what the local California agency has, will be confidentially destroyed unless the local California agency requests them.
