
SUBJECT: WELFARE REFORM TRACKING REQUIREMENTS AND  
REGIONAL TRAINING INFORMATION

This All County Information Notice (ACIN) is being sent to provide information regarding new tracking requirements. On August 22, 1996, President Clinton signed Public Law (PL) 104-193, the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act (PRWORA) of 1996. PRWORA required states to implement significant changes to the delivery of services and tracking of welfare recipients and their benefits. As a result, California passed Assembly Bill (AB) 1542 (Chapter 270, Statutes of 1997), which implements federal law in California. This ACIN focuses on the tracking system that has been developed for the programs operated by the California Department of Social Services (CDSS), primarily California Work Opportunity and Responsibility for Kids (CalWORKs). "Welfare reform" as used in this letter is limited to programs administered by CDSS.

Background

Welfare reform imposes limits on the receipt of welfare benefits by parents or caretaker relatives and requires them to satisfy specific employment requirements, unless they are exempt. Therefore, pertinent data for each parent or caretaker relative needs to be reported and tracked statewide. In order to capture and track this information, a new data tracking system has been developed by the Health and Welfare Agency Data Center (HWDC) in conjunction with CDSS and the County Welfare Directors Association (CWDA). The state Department of Health Services (DHS) will continue to rely on the Medi-Cal Eligibility Data System (MEDS) as the state/county interface for PRWORA data systems changes required of their department.

Prior to welfare reform, state law required CDSS and HWDC, in collaboration with the CWDA, to develop a multiple county consortium strategy as a foundation for the Statewide Automated Welfare System (SAWS). The strategy was mandated to include the establishment of



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interface requirements for all welfare systems and other relevant State automated systems, and a statewide mechanism to electronically exchange case information for all applicants and recipients across the consortia systems for eligibility, anti-fraud, and case management purposes. HWDC is responsible for the development, operation, and maintenance of a technical infrastructure, the SAWS Technical Architecture, to implement this strategy.

### Tracking Requirements and SAWS Strategy

Eligibility workers have on-line access to MEDS in all 58 counties. MEDS contains data on all Aid to Families with Dependent Children, now known as CalWORKS, Medi-Cal, Food Stamp, and Supplemental Security Income/State Supplemental Program recipients in California. Some of the data elements required for tracking are contained in MEDS (see Attachment I).

The SAWS Information System (SIS) is a new database which will summarize all information known to the State concerning each recipient's welfare program involvements and any other information required to administer welfare laws, rules, and regulations. SIS will be the State's long-term solution in meeting tracking requirements. Prior to the statewide implementation of SAWS, California will utilize the SIS, with county access via the MEDS infrastructure, as an interim solution to provide data which fulfills the welfare reform tracking requirements. Beginning in early April of 1998, counties will be able to access SIS using the existing MEDS infrastructure. SIS will be an "inquiry-only" system for the counties, with updates being transmitted electronically through the existing MEDS update process to HWDC. No negative impact on MEDS is anticipated, and CDSS, HWDC, and DHS have agreed to monitor this process to assure this outcome.


CDSS and HWDC formed a Welfare Reform Tracking Work Group with DHS and county staff to develop the SIS, and to incorporate the new tracking requirements. Information will be captured from MEDS that goes back to November 1996 for purposes of tracking Federal and State time limits. We have also included copies of the initial screens which have been developed by the work group (see Attachment II). These screens are designed to display the required welfare reform data.

### Training Information and Next Steps

A more detailed letter will be distributed to you within the next month which will provide you with instructions on what the required data elements are, how to use the screens, and other training materials. Regionalized training sessions for county training personnel have been scheduled beginning March 26, 1998. See Attachment III for training dates, sites and additional information.






## **FRESNO COUNTY PARKING**



TAKE THAT EXIT: TURN LEFT AND GO ACROSS THE I-5 BRIDGE. THE ROAD YOU ARE ON IS SOUTH BONNYVIEW. CONTINUE ON ACROSS THE BRIDGE AND PAST ONE STOP LIGHT. STAY ON SOUTH BONNYVIEW AND FOLLOW THE ROAD ACROSS THE SACRAMENTO RIVER. YOU WILL COME TO ANOTHER STOPLIGHT DOWN THE ROAD A WAYS. TURN RIGHT AT THIS STOPLIGHT - YOU ARE NOW ON EAST BONNYVIEW. STAY THIS ROAD EVEN THOUGH AS YOU GO AROUND A FORTY-FIVE DEGREE CORNER THE NAME WILL CHANGE TO RADIO LANE. YOU WILL PASS TWO LITTLE CANAL BRIDGES AND THEN TURN RIGHT AT THE NEXT STREET WHICH IS CALLED VETERANS LANE. WHEN YOU COME TO THE STOP SIGN AT THE END OF VETERANS LANE, THE SOCIAL SERVICES BUILDINGS ARE RIGHT IN FRONT OF YOU. YOU MUST ENTER THE BUILDING FROM THE CLIENT ENTRANCE SO TURN RIGHT AND GO INTO THAT PARKING LOT. ENTER THE BUILDING AND GO DIRECTLY TO THE RECEPTION AREA WHERE YOU MUST CHECK IN AND RECEIVE A VISITOR'S PASS. WE ARE A LOCKED FACILITY FOR SECURITY REASONS, AND YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ADMITTANCE TO ANY OTHER DOOR.





