The purpose of this letter is to inform you that for report months August 2009 through September 2010, counties are to suspend submission of the Welfare to Work-Assembly Bill (WTW-AB) 98 California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) Subsidized Employment Claimed Under AB 98 report form. This reporting suspension is the result of the temporary suspension of the AB 98 subsidized employment program and initiation and implementation for expansion of CalWORKs subsidized employment programs through the Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Emergency Contingency Fund authorized by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009.

A temporary report to collect data on the ARRA subsidized employment program is being developed for use beginning with the August 2009 report month. This report will have only a minimum number of data cells. The form and instructions will be released in a forthcoming ACL.
