The purpose of this errata is to correct the chart referenced in ACL No. 11-88, dated December 30, 2011. The Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2012 IRT chart attachment in ACL No. 11-88 incorrectly identifies the IRT level for an Assistance Unit (AU) of nine as \$491. The correct IRT level for an AU of nine is \$4,491. This IRT level became effective October 1, 2011. This letter introduces the revised IRT chart with the corrected figure.

\* The figures on the chart for all AU sizes in both Regions are based on the October 2011 CalFresh gross income limits (130 percent of FPL). This year, CalFresh gross income limits are higher than the CalWORKs MAP levels for all reporting sizes in both Regions. Therefore, income at 130 percent of FPL or greater would render the family financially ineligible. CalWORKs MAP levels were not used to establish the IRT.
