The purpose of this letter is to inform counties that effective July 1, 2002, counties are to suspend submission of the SCP Monthly Caseload Movement Statistical Report, form SC 12, to the California Department of Social Services (CDSS). The SC 12 report for June 2002 will be the last report counties are required to submit to CDSS until further notification by CDSS.

As stated in All County Information Notice (ACIN) I-73-02, dated September 20, 2002, the Fiscal Year 2002/03 Budget Act did not appropriate funds for the SCP thus making the program non-operational as of July 1, 2002.
