
Guidelines have been prepared for assisting you in obtaining proper reimbursement for welfare-related child support activities. Meeting sites and dates for presentation of these guidelines to all counties are attached for your convenience. Find your county in the left-hand column of the alphabetical list attached and a "Meeting Site Code" next to your county. Then, looking at the "Meeting Sites", "Dates and Time" columns to the right for your code number, you'll find the site, date and time for your county meeting.

Because of limited space and in order to achieve maximum benefit for all concerned, we suggest keeping the number of people attending to a maximum of three people from each county. (We realize some more involved counties may need more people participating. If this is the case in your county, please call Norm Moe at 916/445-7046, and advise how many will attend in order to reserve adequate space.) We further suggest that those attending should be representatives from each office of the District Attorney, County Welfare Director, and the County Auditor/Controller.

The only tools that are necessary to bring are your new manuals, "Federal Funding for Support Enforcement", pads and pencils. We strongly recommend that the selected participants read the manual before attending the meeting and hopefully have questions ready.
