SUBJECT: IN-HOME SUPPORTIVE SERVICES PENDING FAIR HEARING


Both this Department and the Department of Health have recently received inquiries regarding the applicability of the requirements of timely notice (MPP Section 22-022.1) and assistance pending a fair hearing (MPP Section 22-022.4) to county actions affecting In-Home Supportive Services.

This Department and the Department of Health have concluded that it is necessary to provide both adequate and timely notice and assistance pending a fair hearing where a county action would result in a discontinuance, termination, suspension, withholding or reduction of In-Home Supportive Services. Effectively immediately, you are instructed to provide adequate and timely notice in all actions affecting the previously authorized level of In-Home Supportive Services, and to continue the provision of these services pending a fair hearing in accordance with MPP Section 22-022.4.

Revisions to the state fair hearing regulations to clearly reflect this policy will be forthcoming in the near future.
