The attached report shows the status of the Support Enforcement Incentive Fund (SEIF) through September, 1974.


Since the last report was published, Alameda County has exceeded the million-dollar mark for total SEIF recoveries. The combined efforts of the District Attorney's Office and the Welfare Department in that county, which have made this degree of incentive payments possible, have been outstanding. The results speak for themselves.

Congratulations also to Butte County for passing the one-hundred-thousand-dollar mark last month. This brings the total number of counties enjoying this honor to twenty-six.

The new federal funding program is well under way and all counties have now had an opportunity to participate in the instructional workshops that were held throughout the state. It may be of interest to you that California is the only state in the nation to have implemented this new funding to date. The enthusiastic reception to the program, as demonstrated by the extent of your participation in these workshops, has been very encouraging.

With this type of enthusiastic support, California will certainly continue to lead the nation in the enforcement of support obligations.
