TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DEPARTMENTS

SUBJECT: STATE NEED FOR FORMS SSP 5I AND SSP 5C ON EXCESS VALUE HOME CASES

REFERENCE:

Regulation 46-330 provides for payments to persons who are ineligible for SSI/SSP solely because they own homes valued in excess of federal resource limitations. "Excess Value Home" (EVH) payments under this regulation are fully funded by the State.

Fairly rapid increases in the market value of homes have created a need for the Department to give close attention to the EVH caseload. Summary data on EVH applications approved (Item 13a, Form ABD 216) are insufficient for this purpose.

The forms, "Application and Statement of Facts for Assistance" (Forms SSP 5I and SSP 5C), which are completed by all applicants for EVH, contain the information needed by the Department to develop the necessary statistical data and to provide a basis for adequate responses to legislative inquiries concerning the EVH program.

Accordingly, county welfare departments are requested to provide the Department of Benefit Payments with a copy of:

1. The Form SSP 5I or SSP 5C most recently completed by each recipient or recipient couple receiving, during the month of June 1975, payments under the provisions of Regulation 46-330; and
2. Each Form SSP 5I or SSP 5C hereafter completed as part of any application approved under the provisions of 46-330; and
3. Each Form SSP 5I or SSP 5C hereafter completed in connection with redeterminations of eligibility of recipients receiving payments under the provisions of 46-330 where continued eligibility is established.


