ALL-COUNTY LETTER NO. 75-43

TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: ROLLOBACK PROJECT

REFERENCE:

This is to confirm and modify our December 30, 1974 telegram to counties on the current status of the ATD "Rollback" Project.

P.L. 93-256 requires that ATD recipients under the former State Plan who began receiving aid after July 1, 1973, be reevaluated under the disability criteria of the new federally administered Title XVI Program (SSI). Federal regulations further provide for continued payments to affected cases while their disability status is being determined under the new law, but not beyond December 31, 1974.

Counties were informed in the December 30 telegram that SSA had moved the deadline for completing their review of rollback cases from December 31, 1974, to January 31, 1975. It was indicated that recipients would receive a payment for January although the review of their disability had not been completed. The Department of Benefit Payments has since been notified by SSA that such recipients will continue to receive payment until a rollback decision has been made. The recipients have been notified by SSA that they will receive SSI benefits until a medical redetermination has been completed.

This department has been informed that the Disability Determination Section (DDS) is developing new medical data on the few cases still requiring rollback decisions, and that there should not be any need for further county involvement in these cases. A member of the Adult Program Management Branch or the Disability Determination Section will contact a county if any further follow-up action is necessary on a remaining rollback case.
