ALL-COUNTY LETTER No. 76-5

TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: IMPLEMENTATION OF REVISED FORM WR 6 AND ALIEN REGULATIONS

REFERENCE: ALL-COUNTY LETTER NO. 75-206, EAS 42-433.3

A large volume of the Form WR 6 (Alien Status Verification) is currently being sent to the three regional offices of Immigration and Nationalization Service (Los Angeles, San Francisco and San Diego) despite the new alien referral procedures contained in recent revision to EAS 42-433.3. One of the features of the new system provides for referral to the INS only those cases in which documentation of alien status is not available or of doubtful authenticity. As the documentation of alien status is essential to the new procedures, counties should make every attempt to obtain acceptable INS documentation prior to sending a Form WR 6 to the INS. Unless an alien applicant insists that he has lost, or never had, INS documentation, he should be asked to provide it.

Your cooperation should serve to substantially allay our long standing processing problems in this area.
