TO: ALL WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: AFDC PROTECTIVE PAYMENT FUNDING FOR SANCTIONED IV-D CASES

REFERENCE:

The current Comprehensive Annual Services Plan describes certain functions related to Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) Protective Payments as part of the Protective Services for Children Program. Specifically, activity "k" of the Protective Services for Children definition states: "assuring the provision of the required substitute payee in AFDC Protective Payment cases." During Fiscal Year 1975/76 this activity was funded under Title XX.

Effective July 1, 1976, the protective payment function for sanctioned child support cases will be funded from Title IV-A, AFDC and will be considered an eligibility function. As there are very few of these cases statewide, it is anticipated the administrative costs will be insignificant.

Eligibility workers are required to perform this activity and are to record their time to Line A1, AFDC Intake, on the DFA 43, Eligibility Time Study. This time is then accumulated and their salaries claimed in the normal procedure. This information is in the process of being integrated into state regulations.
