• TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: PROPOSED REVISED ADOPTION ALLOCATION FY 1979-80

Recent estimates of current year expenditures for the Adoptions program project an expenditure level which exceeds budgeted funds. This Department and the Governor have recognized this and are strongly committed to providing the necessary funds for the program.

The 1980-81 Governor's Budget proposes that the anticipated current year deficiency be funded. The level of the proposed deficiency will be reassessed in May. The interim proposed revised allocation for Fiscal Year 1979-80 is attached. Prior to actual allocation of these funds, a Section 28 letter must be submitted to the Legislature for approval. Although favorable action by the Legislature is anticipated, funding levels above the original allocation cannot be firmly committed until legislative approval is received.
