SUBJECT: FY 1981/82 ALLOCATIONS FOR STAFF DEVELOPMENT TITLE IVA, ELIGIBILITY
AND NONSERVICE-STATE FUNDS

REFERENCE:

Attached is each county's State fund allocation for eligibility and nonservice (Title IVA) Staff Development. This funding was provided for in the State Budget Act of 1981, and it was based on a state share equal to 12½ percent (Federal 75 percent, County 12½ percent).

As a result of changes in Federal priorities, their financial participation will decrease from seventy-five percent to fifty percent as of October 1, 1981. Sharing will be fifty percent Federal, twenty-five percent State, and twenty-five percent County for those counties not exceeding the State allocation. Those counties exceeding the State allocation will be matching at a fifty percent level. The appropriate state level organizations are aware of the change in Federal sharing and resultant shortage of state matching funds. It is unknown at this time if any additional state funds will be provided.

The allocation is based on a 2:1 ratio of prior expenditures (FY 1980/81) and eligibility workers, full-time equivalent for the same time period.
