TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: NOTICE OF ACTION MESSAGES - ABSENT PARENT IN THE UNIFORMED SERVICES

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS IN TRANSFERS FROM MEDICALLY NEEDY TO AFDC

REFERENCE: EAS 41-450.3, EAS 40-183.5 (ORD #982-52)

On February 7, 1983, we sent you an All-County Welfare Director's Letter with an advance copy of regulations that affect the Beginning Date of Aid, Absence Based on Duty in the Uniformed Services and Rounding of Payment Amounts (ORD #982-52). In that letter we stated that the regulations had been signed by the Director and submitted to the Office of Administrative Law. We estimated that those regulations would be filed on March 1, 1983 and would become effective on April 1, 1983. We will let you know the effective date after the regulations are filed.

This is to provide notice of action messages (English and Spanish) regarding continued absence of a parent on duty in the Uniformed Services (EAS 41-450.3), and to clarify that an application (CA-1) is required when an individual transfers from Medically Needy to AFDC Cash Grant Recipient status.

The notice of action messages attached are to be used on the appropriate Notice of Action forms when reducing, discontinuing, or denying aid in accordance with the provisions of EAS 41-450.3. The messages are not to be used until the regulations are effective. Notice of Action language is not required for the rounding of payment amounts or the change in the beginning date of aid for transfers from Medically Needy to AFDC.

You will note that Sections 40-183.5 and 40-121.3 were revised to require a new application (Form CA-1) when a medically needy person requests a change to cash grant status. Due to an oversight, Section 40-128.12 was not amended to be consistent with this requirement. Regardless of the provisions of 40-128.12, Sections 40-183.5 and 40-121.3 govern the application requirement for an intra-program status change from medically needy to cash grant. Section 40-128.12 will be revised.

NOTICE OF ACTION MESSAGES - ABSENT PARENT IN THE UNIFORMED SERVICES

Discontinuance or Reduction

REASON FOR THE ACTION:

There has been a change in the law. Beginning (effective date of regulations), children are no longer eligible for aid based on the absence of a parent if the only reason for the absence is that the parent is on active duty in the uniformed services of the United States.

According to our records, the only reason (parent's name) is absent is that he/she is on active duty in the (branch of uniformed services) which is a branch of the uniformed services of the United States. If this information is not correct, or you believe that you or your child(ren) may be eligible for aid on some other basis, contact your eligibility worker at once.

REGULATION: EAS 41-450

Denial of Aid

REASON FOR THE ACTION:

Children are not eligible for aid based on the absence of a parent if the only reason for the absence is that the parent is on active duty in the uniformed services of the United States.

According to our records, the only reason (parent's name) is absent is that he/she is on active duty in the (branch of uniformed services) which is a branch of the uniformed services of the United States. If this information is not correct, or you believe that you or your child(ren) may be eligible for aid on some other basis, please contact us at once.

MENSAJES DE NOTIFICACIÓN DE ACCIÓN - PADRE/MADRE AUSENTE EN EL SERVICIO UNIFORMADO

Descontinuación o Reducción

RAZÓN PARA LA ACCIÓN:

Ha habido un cambio en la ley. A partir de (fecha de vigencia de las regulaciones), los niños no siguen siendo elegibles para asistencia basada en la ausencia del padre/la madre si la única razón para dicha ausencia es que el padre/la madre está prestando servicio activo en los servicios uniformados de los Estados Unidos.

De acuerdo a nuestros archivos, la única razón por la que (nombre del padre/la madre) está ausente es que está prestando servicio activo en (rama de los servicios uniformados), el cual es una rama de los servicios uniformados de los Estados Unidos. Si esta información no es correcta, o si usted cree que usted o su(s) niño(s) pueda ser elegible para asistencia basada en otra cosa, comuníquese inmediatamente con su trabajador(a) de elegibilidad.

Negación de Asistencia

RAZÓN PARA LA ACCIÓN:

Los niños no son elegibles para asistencia basada en la ausencia de su padre/madre si la única razón para la ausencia es que el padre/madre está prestando servicio activo en los servicios uniformados de los Estados Unidos.

De acuerdo a nuestros archivos, la única razón por la que (nombre del padre/la madre) está ausente es que está prestando servicio activo en (rama del servicio uniformado), el cual es una rama de los servicios de los Estados Unidos. Si esta información no es correcta, o si usted cree que su(s) niño(s) pueda ser elegible para asistencia basada en otra cosa, por favor comuníquese inmediatamente con nosotros.
