SUBJECT: REASSIGNMENT OF PROGRAM DESIGNATORS 32 AND 33

REFERENCE:

In prior years counties were instructed to use aid codes (program designators) 32 and 33 to identify Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) Money Management Persons Counts. This requirement was in accordance with Federal Regulations (45 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 234). The Federal Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1981 deleted language which stated, if the number of recipients in cases for whom protective payments or payments to persons furnishing goods or services were made in any month does not exceed 10 percent of all other AFDC recipients in that month, all such payments and recipients should be included in computing federal financial participation.

As it is no longer necessary to accumulate the total number of protective payment persons counts, then it is no longer a requirement to identify such payments with a separate program designator. When the CA 800, Summary Report of Assistance Expenditures, Aid to Families with Dependent Children is next revised, the boxes in which money management persons counts were required to be reported will be eliminated; however, it will still be required that all protective payments be identified in the payroll. Whenever possible, the suggested code "A" is to be used on the payroll to identify protective payments. This suggested code may be substituted by a county code upon approval by the Department of Social Services if the county's payroll defines the code used.

Effective October 1, 1984, counties should no longer use program designators 32 and 33 to identify (AFDC) Money Management Persons Counts. It is anticipated that the program designators 32 and 33 will be utilized for the Refugee

Demonstration Project. See All-County Information Notice I-63-84, dated July 9, 1984. Fiscal claiming forms and instructions will be issued at a later date.
