SUBJECT: SHARING RATIOS FOR REPAYMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 1986/87

Effective July 1, 1986, the repayment sharing ratios for AFDC-FG/U, EA-UP, AFDC-FC Federal, EA-FC and AFDC Non-Federal FC will be as follows:

<u>Program</u>	<u>Federal</u>	<u>State</u>	<u>County</u>
AFDC-FG/U	52%	43%	5%
EA-UP	51%	44%	5%
AFDC Federal FC	49%	48%	3%
EA-FC	50%	47%	3%
AFDC Non-Federal FC	-	95%	5%

The ratios for AFDC-FG/U and AFDC-FC are based on a five year moving average of expenditures for calendar years 1981 through 1985. The Emergency Assistance Program ratios are based on 42 months of expenditures, July 1982 through December 1985.

Note that all of the above ratios are identical to Fiscal Year 1985/86 with the exception of the ratios for the AFDC Federal Foster Care and AFDC Non-Federal Foster Care programs. As in the past, inclusion of the 100 percent federal reimbursement for time-eligible refugees results in AFDC-FG/U and EA-UP federal repayment sharing ratios being greater than 50 percent.

Recoveries reported for Old Age Security, Aid to the Blind and Aid to the Totally Disabled will continue to be shared on the basis of the five-year moving average prior to SSI/SSP conversion: 48 percent federal, 37 percent state and 15 percent county.
