TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: REDISTRIBUTION OF SURPLUS FUNDS FOR FY 1986/87 IN THE SMALL PROGRAM BLOCK GRANT ALLOCATION

The purpose of this letter is to provide the county welfare departments with a revised FY 1986/87 Small Program Block Grant (SPBG) allocation. This revision supersedes your SPBG allocation that was transmitted via All County Letter No. 86-64.

In response to county concerns regarding the adequacy of the staff development portion of the SPBG allocation and the delay in receiving an offset to deficit situations, the Department has reviewed its policy on redistribution of surplus funds and allocation transferability. Beginning with FY 1986/87, policy was implemented to redistribute any surplus funds in the SPBG allocation during the year-end reallocation process, rather than distributing surplus funds during the close-out process, which occurs two years following the end of a fiscal year. The attached SPBG allocation reflects this change in policy. In addition, counties that continued to be in a deficit situation after the reallocation process received an offset of all or part of their remaining deficit in SPBG from any surplus funds in their Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) or Non Assistance Food Stamps (NAFS) (salaries and overhead) allocations. No further adjustment will be made for counties who remain in a deficit situation.

Reimbursement of FY 1986/87 fourth quarter costs was based on this revised SPBG allocation. For those counties who did not exceed their original SPBG allocation and submit FY 1986/87 supplemental claims within the 18 month claiming period, reimbursement will be allowed up to their original SPBG allocation for FY 1986/87 (Reference ACL 86-64).
