SUBJECT: ELIMINATION OF INTERLOCUTORY DECREE

This letter serves as notice that as of January 1, 1988 the interlocutory decree for adoption will no longer be available.

Assembly Bill 1454 (Chapter 360, Statutes of 1987, Mojonnier) brought California into conformance with federal law changes. The federal law, and conforming State law, have deleted the requirement for an interlocutory decree of adoption and have substituted the adoption placement agreement as a prerequisite to initiating the payment of Adoption Assistance Program (AAP) benefits. Thus AAP benefits may be paid immediately after an adoptive placement is made as long as an adoption assistance agreement has also been signed.

Departmental regulations are being promulgated to implement this legislation. You will have an opportunity to review and comment on the new regulations before they are effective.
