TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: FOOD STAMP FORMS DFA 377.1A (1/88)  
AND TEMP DFA 377.10 (10/87)

REFERENCE: ALL COUNTY LETTER 88-22, dated February 9, 1988

All County Letter 88-22, dated February 19, 1988, transmitted the revised Notice of Approval, DFA 377.1 (1/88); Notice of Denial or Pending Status, DFA 377.1A (1/88); and instructions for completing the forms. The purpose of this letter is to inform counties of a change in the instructions for the DFA 377.1A (1/88).

Under the current instructions, counties are to use the DFA 377.1A (1/88) to notify a household of a denial of an application. They also require that the DFA 377.10 be sent if a household is denied because of noncompliance with work requirements by the principal work registrant (PWR). The change is being made in response to concerns of counties that two notices of action are required when this circumstance occurs.

Counties may now elect to use the Temp DFA 377.10 (10/87) to notify a household of the denial of an application if the reason for denial is due solely to noncompliance with work requirements by the PWR. The DFA 377.1A would not have to be sent in this circumstance. If a member other than the PWR has failed to comply, both forms must be sent.

When using the Temp DFA 377.10 (10-87) to notify a household of denial of an application, check the "Other" box and insert the following phrase: "Your household's application for Food Stamps has been denied." In the space provided under "Here's why", enter the name of the PWR who did not comply with the Food Stamp Employment and Training Program rules.
