SUBJECT: AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN - EMERGENCY
ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (AFDC-EA) STATISTICAL REPORTING

RE: ALL-COUNTY LETTER NO. 90-92, AB 3232 (BATES)

The purpose of this letter is to notify you of statistical reporting changes necessitated by the termination of the Emergency Assistance (EA) Program on September 30, 1990.

As stated in ACL 90-92, reporting on the AFDC-EA statistical report (Form CA 237 EA) will no longer be necessary. The termination of the EA program will also require changes to AFDC-FG/U (CA 237 FG/U) and AFDC-Foster Care (FC) (CA 237 FC) statistical reporting. Items 4a(2) and 7d.(3) of both the AFDC-FG/U and the AFDC-FC reports refer to EA activity. Until these reports can be revised, please report "0" in these items for both reports. When the revisions are completed, the reports will be added to the warehouse supply for ordering by counties.
