SUBJECT: DELAY OF IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ORTEGA v. ANDERSON
DECISION IN THE AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN
(AFDC) PROGRAM

REFERENCE: ALL COUNTY LETTER (ACL) 97-30

The purpose of this letter is to notify you to cease implementation of the Ortega v. Anderson decision in the AFDC program. ACL 97-30, dated May 1, 1997, provided you with proposed draft regulations and implementation instructions necessary to implement effective July 1, 1997. These draft regulations will not be finalized and ACL 97-30 is rescinded.

In response to concerns raised by the counties, the Department has arranged a delay of implementation while alternative regulations can be developed. It is anticipated that implementation of the new regulations will occur by December 1, 1997.
