

SUBJECT: DISCONTINUANCE OF TRANSITIONAL CHILD CARE (TCC) CASELOAD MOVEMENT REPORT, CA 237 TCC

The Transitional Child Care Caseload Movement Report, CA 237 (copy attached), is being discontinued. Although the counties have already recognized the need to discontinue collecting data regarding the TCC program, this is official notification that March 1998 is the last month for which data is required on this report.

Collection of child care information for persons no longer on aid will occur on a new form, the Child Care Monthly Report (CW 115). This form is being released through a separate ACL and will become effective April 1998.
