INVESTIGATIONS AND PROGRAM INTEGRITY EFFORTS  
RELATED TO THE IN-HOME SUPPORTIVE SERVICES (IHSS)  
PROGRAM

REFERENCE: County Board of Supervisors Letter dated  
September 25, 2009

The Budget Act of 2009 included \$10 million General Fund (GF) for the purpose of fraud prevention, detection, referral, investigation, prosecution and additional program integrity efforts related to the IHSS Program. With matching federal funds and required county matching funds the total amount available statewide is \$26.4 million.

Forty-five counties submitted plans that were coordinated and developed in conjunction with the County Welfare Directors and District Attorneys. All plans and requests for funding were reviewed and approved by the County Boards of Supervisors and the California Department of Social Services. To date, 29 counties have met the requirements and have been approved to receive the amount listed in Attachment I.

Of the \$10 million GF, \$8.9 million has been allocated to the 29 counties whose plans have been approved. Funds were allocated based on a percent to statewide total of the IHSS basic allocation. The amount intended for non-participating counties was distributed to the counties that requested more than the original allocation amount. Funding for the remaining 16 counties will be allocated in a subsequent CFL pending approval of their county plans. Claiming instructions will be forthcoming in a separate CFL.
